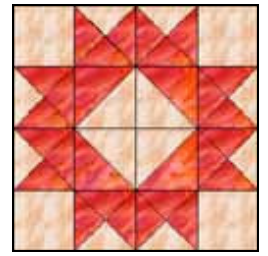

### Foothills Quilters Guild Minutes May 24, 2007

The Foothills Quilters Guild met on May 24, 2007 at the Ascension Lutheran Church in Shelby, North Carolina. Molly Savage, acting for the President, welcomed all members and visitors.

Suzy Bridges, Vice President-membership, introduced visitors Judy Kursted, Edith Brackett, Christine Smith, Tanya Ortiz-Gansley, Linda Jozwishowki, and Donna Thomas. Last month Lea Day joined the guild, and tonight the guild gained three new members, Christine Smith, Eula Crews, and Becky Whelan.

Minutes for the last meeting were approved as written. There is a correction to the newsletter; Molly said that in the information on our speaker for tonight, she has written that Dottie Moore had been quilting since 1875. Obviously, this should have been 1975.

Ann Hutchins, Librarian, announced we had no new books this month and she had passed out slips to members that had overdue books and asked that they check to see if they did have the overdue books. The pray list was updated.

Ginny Huntley, Quilt Show Chair, reminded members that the show is in 5 months and to continue working on our entries. Ginny had the book Showtime Quilters Guide & Directory for July – December 2007 and she showed the page with our Quilt Show advertisement. Ginny said that this advertisement was free to the club and the book would be placed in the library. Ginny announced that the Quilt show rules and registration form was in the May newsletter, as well as being on the guild's web site. Each entry needs a registration form and the forms can be copied. At the June guild meeting there will be volunteer sign up sheets for the quilt show. Volunteers are needed for many areas; more details to come at the June meeting. When you drop off and pick up your entries for the quilt show, you will sign a form instead of getting a slip of paper for your entries. Molly said that more workers to help decorate the quilt show would be welcome. Paula Barringer announced that the donation quilt was available if someone wanted to use it to sell tickets at work, etc.

Eleanor Morgan announced that the Square In A Square workshop, taught by Shirley Hummel, would be 11 August and would cost \$35. The workshop would start at 9:00 am and the cost of the class includes the kit fee and the cost of renting the church. August 11 is the UFO day, and the class and UFO will share the room. A sign-up sheet for the workshop was at the front desk.

Teresa Bourne asked that all recipes for the guild show cookbook be in by next month. You can email them to Sally Norman or give them to Teresa or Sylvia Lancaster. Teresa said they were over loaded with dessert recipes and could use recipes for anything else.

Dee Batayte announced that a letter from the North Carolina Quilt Symposium Inc. had been emailed to the guilds web site. The letter is asking for volunteers to serve on the Board of Directors for NCQSI. A copy of the letter is on the web site, and a copy will be in the June newsletter.

## ***Wanted – Quilt Show Volunteers . . . from Gary Hartley***

A successful quilt show will depend on the members who step forward to volunteer their time and effort. Following is a list of some areas that could use your help. Sign up sheets will be out at the June, July, and August meetings for members to sign up. Shirley Runyans, volunteer coordinator, may also be contacting you about volunteering. Put some thought into what you would like to do and step forward and sign up.

**BOUTIQUE** – Ellen Yunker could use some help in setting it up. She will also need volunteers to sell items and collect money on the 3 days of the show.

**DECORATIONS** – Molly Savage could use help in decorating the arts council building for the show.

**DONATION QUILT TICKETS** – members to be at the table to sell tickets during the show.

**DOOR PRIZES** – Linda Greene needs volunteers to stay at the door prize table to give prizes to winners.

**FAT ¼ BASKET** – volunteers to sell tickets to win the basket – Suzy Bridges is chairman of this.

**HOSPITALITY** - Sylvia Lancaster is in charge of the kitchen and needs help in keeping it organized and seeing that food is put out and covered, etc. Members will also be asked to donate food, drinks, and other items for the 3 days of the show. We do this so that during the show members have food and drinks available and don't have to leave to get them.

**ADMISSIONS** – Take up the \$3.00 admissions and give visitors programs and explain procedures.

**HOSTESSES** - You wear white gloves and handle the quilts for visitors that may want to see the back, etc.

**SET-UP AND TAKE DOWN** - Kaye Young and Eleanor Morgan are in charge. On Monday, October 8 we could use any men to help assemble the frames and set them up (cordless drills come in handy if they have one). Female members are needed to sort the quilts and begin to put up the backdrops for the wall hangings. On Tuesday help is needed to hang all quilts and wall hangings. There is plenty to be done by anyone interested. You will not have to climb ladders, so please sign up to help. We will be hanging from 9:30am until we drop on Monday and Tuesday. Hopefully we will have it up by Tuesday afternoon. It's a lot of hard work but great fun plus you get up close and personal with all the quilts. On Sunday at 4:30pm we could use male and female help taking down the show, folding quilts and getting them to their correct table for distribution.

I'm sure I have left out some areas that need help. As you can see, it takes the entire guild to put on a show. Come out and participate and have some fun in the process.

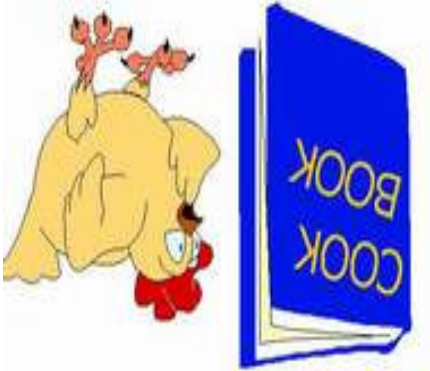
